

Did you know . . . on Security POCs and PII August 13, 2012

2...that, thanks to Travis Petty, we now have a list of Anti-Terrorism (AT), Operational Security (OPSEC), and physical security POCs within Army Europe that you can refer requiring activities to if they have questions about the AT/OPSEC coversheet? The list is attached here for your reference.

3...that OASA(ALT) issued a memorandum on 16 July with the subject "Personally Identifiable Information (PII) Contractual Concerns", regarding Personally Identifiable Information (PII) under the control of contractors? This memo states that a policy memorandum with PII language for work statements and additional contractual considerations will be forthcoming. As applicable, it states that KOs should conduct the following activities as this information is developed: (1) work with requiring activities to identify work that calls for the design, development, or operation of a system of records on individuals; (2) ensure that work statements specifically identify such systems; (3) include FAR clauses 52.224-1 and 52.224-2 in solicitations and contracts, and; (4) reference DoD PII procedures and DoD Directive 5400.11 and 5400.11-R in solicitations and contracts.
