Lieutenant Colonel Robert C. Murray was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army in 1994 as a Distinguished Military Graduate, and received his B.S. in Sociology at Portland State University (Oregon). His first assignment was in the 25th Infantry Division (ID) from 1995-1998 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii where he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader and Executive Officer (XO) of a Rifle Company in the 2nd Battalion (BN), 35th Infantry Regiment (CACTI). He also served as the XO of Headquarters & Headquarters Company (HHC), 25th ID. Following his branch transfer to the Quartermaster Corps in 1998, LTC Murray was assigned to 602nd Aviation Support BN, 2nd ID at Camp Stanley, Korea as the BN S4 from 1999-2000. After his tour in Korea he was assigned to the 505th Quartermaster (QM) BN, Okinawa, Japan where he served as Commander of HHC, 505th QM BN and BN S2/3 from 2000-2003. LTC Murray was assessed into the Army Acquisition Corps in 2003 and selected for Advanced Civil Schooling (ACS). He received a M.S in Management with a concentration in Logistics Management from the Florida Institute of Technology in 2004. Following ACS LTC Murray was assigned to the 45th Corps Support Group (reflagged as 8th Theater Support Command) at Fort Shafter, Hawaii from 2004-2006 and served as a Contingency Contracting Officer (CCO). Upon completing his 2 year tour in Hawaii LTC Murray was assigned to the 10th Support Group, Torii Station, Okinawa, Japan. He served as a CCO before being reassigned to the 411th Contracting Support Brigade (CSB) (Korea) as the 650th Contingency Contracting Team Leader with continued duty in Okinawa, Japan at the 18th Contracting Squadron, 18th Wing, Kadena Airbase from 2007-2010. LTC Murray deployed in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM from May 2010 - April 2011 and was assigned to CENTCOM Contracting Command as the Construction Chief at Regional Contracting Center (RCC)-Kandahar Air Field prior to assuming duty as Chief of RCC-North in Northern Afghanistan. Following his tour in Afghanistan LTC Murray was assigned to 412TH CSB as the Brigade S3 and XO from 2011-2013.

Military Education: Infantry Officers Basic Course, Infantry Mortar Leaders Course, Supply Systems Officers Management Course, Petroleum Officers Course, Combined Captain Career Course, CAS3, ILE, 51C Intermediate Qualification Course, and Army Acquisition Basic Course.
